Capacity Building Session with Journalists

"Using Direct Taxation to Tackle Inequality and Boost Revenue"

On 29 May 2022, Bangladesh's Research and Policy Integration for Development (RAPID) hosted a capacity-building workshop with seven journalists from the country's main publications.
